- 4. To improve tourists, security by establishing a tourist center, setting up CCTVs in Railey area, setting up warning and road signs, and setting up a security team to make sure that everyone is safe;
- 5. To cultivate awareness of nature conservation on youths and tourists alike by inviting them to take part in beach cleaning activities, to learn about ecosystem restoration, and to plant beach forest trees.

Not only are we proud as the locals here, we also take pride in working together to preserve this beautiful land so that everyone can experience the value and beauty of this gem for generations to come.
