

Sustainable Development Goals

Rayavadee is continually working to improve the impact we have on people and places. We are committed to reducing our greenhouse gas emissions and to protecting and supporting biodiversity.

As part of that commitment, in 2025 we set ourselves a target of reducing our greenhouse gas emissions from energy and waste by 10% at the end of 2026. We also set a target to reduce of water consumption by 20% in 2025 compared to year 2024 and we will install a rainwater tanks that will be used to watering on our gardens.

Additionally, we have set ourselves a target to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions from energy, water consumption and waste by 5% at the end of year 2025 and by 30% within 2030.

Rayavadee aims to remove all trash from our 3 beaches by the end of 2025, and we will have planted 500 trees as part of a local reforestation project by the end of 2026. We are implementing new initiatives throughout our operations to achieve our goal of 2030.

We encourage our guests, staffs and the visitors to support us by following the campaign we have provided throughout the hotel about saving water and energy, as well as minimizing waste.

In addition to our environmental initiatives, Rayavadee is deeply committed to supporting the local community and making a positive, lasting impact. We actively collaborate with local stakeholders and contribute to preserving sacred sites, such as the Shrine of Phranang, to ensure these cultural treasures are protected for future generations.

Rayavadee is committed to respecting and protecting human rights. We believe that everyone should be treated fairly and with respect. As part of this commitment, we regularly train our staff to prevent discrimination.

We are also committed to safeguarding the welfare of children and young people. We have a policy of always reporting suspected instances of child exploitation and abuse to the police. We encourage our guests, staffs and the visitors to report their own concerns about child exploitation and abuse to the local police by calling 191 or reporting directly to the police station that located in Ao-nang police station, Tambon Ao-nang, Muang, Krabi 81180.
