On the sharpest point of the curving Phranang Peninsula, Rayavadee Resort is a class apart, with coconut groves swaying in the breeze and a sweet coastal scent drifting along the pathways to the hotel's two-floor pavilions. In its three decades, this refuge has mastered the art of providing guests with choices. Should you desire a private sauna, there is a villa so equipped. If in need of a butler, a service can be offered for your stay. Should you prefer something quieter and closer than the ocean, there are leafy villas with private pools in the front garden.
